Workshop (Jan):

How should a well consolidated use case of openPASS look like? The BMW interpretation of the OSC-ALKS Scenarios <https://github.com/arausichert/OSC-ALKS-scenarios> are a good example and a good summary of the regulation.

openSCENARIO files could be successfully simulated by Mercedes.

The focus of openPass: only simulation of the scenarios, without analysis and assessment. For analysis metrics are needed which the openPASS WG doesn't provide.

Then, the group discussed how to define similar use cases.

Jan explained the idea of describing similar concrete use cases (e.g. use openPASS or development of additional openPASS features as part of funded R&D projects).

Jan raised the idea to update the standard slides wrt use cases (currently only examples) and reflect on the website the use cases known to the WG in more detail (such as PCM simulation, traffic simulation for accident research and scenario-based testing). This content could as well be included in the documentation.

Furthermore, the identification of common use cases could be used to drive the development and derive requirements for future development steps.

There will be a follow up discussion in 2021 on how to proceed.

SC (Tuan):

HEADSTART

On December 3rd, 2020 Tuan and Jorge had a meeting with the EU-funded project HEADSTART. HEADSTART is currently exploring whether openPASS is a possible simulation tool for their purposes. They want to use it for V2X communication, but it is not implemented in openPASS. Whenever they want to use this feature, they need to develop this function by themselves. Tuan will reply to HEADSTART.

Release Review

The release review by BMW is ongoing. The CQ regarding protobuf is ongoing. It will be finished in approximately one week.

SUMO Exchange

The discussion about a possible collaboration will continue in January.
