Plan repository management/ Dealing with additional feature branches

Currently the ITK branch contains a mix of old (v0.6 content, incompatible GUI, ...) and new (collision calculation, csv export, ...) features. To resolve the issue a new parallel branch will be created which will contain the current content of the ITK branch. The new branch will be named HLRS. The new branch will be temporarily, bug fixes can be done without modifying other branches, the cmake build system will be on the branch and it will not have more functionalities than the master. It is in discussion that Uwe Woessner will be the responsible person of the new HLRS branch. For now, the openPASS WG has no rights to delete any branches but with the migration to GitLab there should be a possibility to delete the branch. There is no automated commit to v0.7 without any agreement in the SC.

Once the migration to GitLab happens the openPASS WG will discuss about the further proceeding of the branch HLRS.

The SC agrees to introduce an HLRS branch. The decision of the SC can be found [here](#).

New reduced GUI will be committed on top of 0.7.

Updates EclipseCon

As a product manager Tuan will hold the talk at the EclipseCon. The talk should give a glance at the simulation platform openPASS. Thus, the standard slides are being used. The Community Day is free of charge. Everyone is welcome to join the community day.

Cooperation with OpenADx

There will be discussions with openADx about a possible collaboration. The objective is to connect different simulation tools and simulation-middleware together to obtain a Co-simulation with elements from Sumo, PreScan, OpenMCX and eventually openPASS.

The discussions have just started recently and openPASS will participate at the next meeting.

The SC suggests building up the project on a real-world use case. In general, the SC appreciates those discussions.

Updates will follow in the next SC-meeting.
