1. Eclipse Release Review

2. Status report on refinement of Epics/Stories for Release 0.8

In our last workshop we ended with tasks for all partners to write user stories. Please write the user stories assigned to you until our SC on Thursday, November 19th.

3. Feedback on PCM Commit

Intech conducted a code review on the PCM commit (<https://git.eclipse.org/r/c/simopenpass/simopenpass/+/170112>). Mercedes and ITK will plan the next steps in the upcoming week. BMW and intech are available for questions concerning the code review comments.

In future, a guide for developers should also contain lessons learned from code reviews.

4. Introduction to Gitlab

User stories are currently entered as "Issues"

- As non-committer, only the status can be edited. Any other meta-information cannot be changed.
- Committer or project lead roles are required to edit meta-information for issues
- --> Tuan will clarify with the Eclipse Foundation

Topics to be clarified (Todo's for Tuan):

- How to get the permissions to edit meta information in Issues
- How do other projects use Gitlab? Are releases planed in Gitlab or in a separate tool?
- How to report Bugs?
- What is the process for reviews?

Open topics:

- How to use the wiki? What information do we want to provide in the wiki (e.g. developer information, installation, link collection) and what do we leave to the user documentation?

5. Status update: Abstract Scenario API / OpenSCENARIO implementation

Mercedes is currently clarifying how they can also contribute code.

There will be follow-up requirement refinement meetings with intech, BMW and Mercedes as main participants. Anyone else is welcome to join. Let Arun know if you want to be invited.

6. Discussion: usage of openMDM

Pic solutions approached the openPASS WG to ask if there is any interest in using openMDM as repository for scenarios, maps and other resources. Central repository administration is currently not in the focus of our working group. Therefore, Tuan will respond that there are no planned activities concerning usage of openMDM.
