

## **Minutes of openPASS Steering Committee**

November 16, 2018 – Web conference

## 1. Status Product Manager (TÜV Süd)

Christian informed the group that the recruitment process has started and will inform the other partners as soon as there is more information.

## 2. openPASS goals/planning (=> proposal: "white paper")

Jan will share a first draft of a "whitepaper" to the other partners that will serve a document gathering different perspectives on the potential goals of openPASS as well as next steps. Based on this document, some content can be used for the website and the release planning.

Jan suggested that it is important to strengthen the link to PEARS again. *Strategic goals* (what should ideally be reached with virtual testing / effectiveness assessment by virtual simulation?) should be aligned with e. g. PEARS. Further, more *short-term, "openPASS only" goals regarding the tool functionality* are important, too (=> release planning). But they need to be derived from or aligned to these high-level goals. Jan suggested that a group of PEARS and openPASS representatives should be initiated to define the common openPASS/PEARS scope.
