# DOCUMENTING MODELS




- › Obvious approach is to use Papyrus diagram editor, however:
  - Cumbersome UI
  - Modeler needs to follow design rules
  - Complex to generate automatically
- › A lightweight yet powerful alternative is...

# SO WHAT IS PLANTUML?



- › Open Source tool to draw UML diagrams
- › Based on Graphviz









- › Rendering Managed Object diagrams automatically!







