1. Current developments and future roadmap

The SC has met for a workshop to discuss current developments and the future scope of openPASS. Ongoing developments and future expectations of openPASS by the partners can be found in the presentation slides (<u>link</u>). The prioritization will be done in a follow-up meeting.

2. Release procedure

To avoid delays in the release process as the WG faced it in v0.8, a new approach regarding releasing is defined. The SC/ AC decides whether a new release can be published. The goal is to publish more releases with smaller changes.

3. Repository structure

The SC decided to restructure the repository. To ensure an independent development of the core, new repositories are created. The new repositories contain developments in terms of the GUI and models. Hence, core developments don't interfere with other developments.

A process to merge the different repositories still needs to be developed. The setup of an overarching CI for all repositories must be done. Discussions on implementation details will continue in the AC meetings.

4. Visualization

A standalone visualization will be published by BMW. The release is planned within the next months. The idea is to make the visualization accessible to everyone, so that everyone can contribute and further develop the visualization.
