## 1. Discussion Documentation

The SC discussed the structure of the documentation.

ITK has made a proposal for the structure which can be seen in the issue "[Documentation on PCM use-case](#)". All further discussions regarding the PCM documentation will continue in this issue.

## 2. Cmake Compilation

VW AG (on behalf of VWGoA) has tested the compilation of openPASS 0.7 with cmake.

Using the prerequisites versions indicated in the openPASS documentation, it was possible to build the third party dependencies in a MSYS-Mingw64 shell without issues. The three steps necessary to build openPASS with cmake have been then performed in a MSYS-Mingw64 shell. It was not possible to build openPASS with FMI Libraries, which induced errors in the second step. An openPASS version without FMI libraries could be built, despite errors at the end of the third step, which are considered as not critical. The same building test with cmake will be performed as soon as the next openPASS version 0.8 is released.
